**S**un Microsystems Inc. in Santa Clara, Calif., and **Waveset Technologies Inc.** in Austin, Texas, have formed an alliance to deliver an integrated, standards-based identity management software kit for use with **PeopleSoft** applications. The software is expected to help users manage workforce identity information from a single portal interface.
